#### Important Points to take note:

- Students who are ill should not be in school for tests and examinations. Our Haig girl should seek medical attention as the school cares for her wellbeing and she will not be in the position to give her best effort to the assessment.
- If a student misses a test because of an illness, she needs to submit a medical certificate upon her return. The student, in this case, will not get a '0' for the test. The school will indicate 'VR' (Valid Reason) in her report book and her overall marks will be pro-rated accordingly.
- Students who do not have a valid reason for missing their assessment may get an 'AB
   (Absent)' which will translate to zero mark for that assessment. Please check with the
   school if your child will be missing an assessment for reason/s other than being ill.
- There will be no make-up for the written, listening comprehension and practical assessments.
