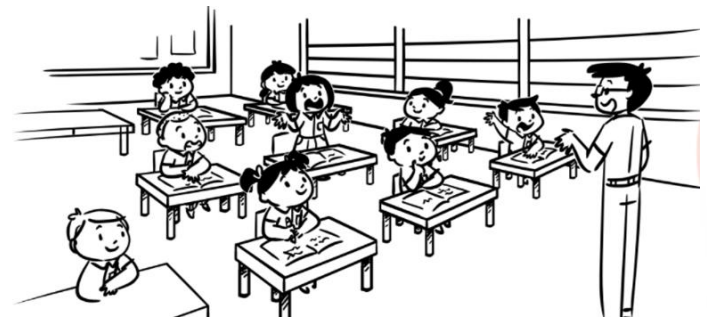

Character and Citizenship Education (CCE)

Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) is at the heart of education in Singapore. Through CCE, students are provided with **school-wide educational experiences** for their **character, social-emotional and civic development**.

Students learn values, **social-emotional competencies**, and develop citizenship dispositions and a sense of purpose that enable them to grow holistically, leading to positive life outcomes.

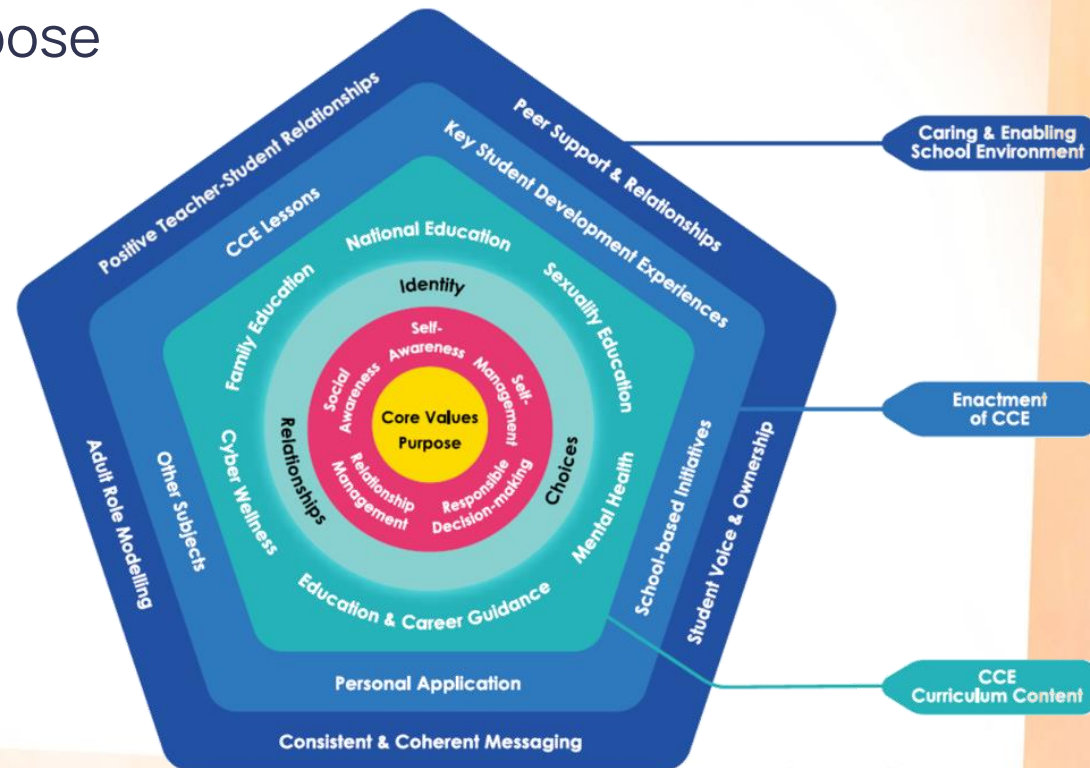


Figure 1: CCE Curriculum Frame
